

Yom Hashoah Memorial Candle



Create a special Yom HaShoah memorial candle holder by repurposing a clear glass votive and some handmade papers into this Yartzeit candle holder.

Supplies needed:

- Mod Podge, or Dick Blick's Gloss Polymer Medium (available at dickblick.com) This will be used as both the glue and sealer.
- Sponge brush for the glue
- Torn pieces of handmade papers(papers available at dickblick.com, or the Paper Source, http://www.paper-source.com
- Jewish star cut out of yellow copy paper
- Words such as "Remember "(Zachor) or "Never Again" may be written on the star prior to gluing it onto the candle holder.
- 3" clear glass votive candle holder
- Memorial candle

Before you begin:

For fire safety, all artwork and glue should be applied to the outside of the candleholder only.

Directions:

Working on one side at a time, spread the glue on to the votive holder. Press pieces of the torn paper on top of the glue. Continue this process around the entire candle holder. Glue the star on to the candle holder. Apply a thin top coat of the glue over the outside to seal the artwork.
