

Send a Talking Shanah Tovah!

Use the free app Fotobabble to send a talking *Shanah Tovah* via email to friends and family around the world. See a sample <u>here</u>.



You will need:

Fotobabble (Free, available for iPhone, iPad, and iTouch)

- **After downloading Fotobabble, tap "Settings" and adjust the "Public" setting to "Off."
- **Free account creation is required to save and send with Fotobabble.

To Create your Talking Shanah Tovah:

- 1. **Decide what picture you would like to have as a background.** You can take a picture of your family, artwork you created, or items that you use to celebrate *Rosh HaShanah*.
- 2. Add a Photo and Edit.
 - a. Tap "**Take a New Photo**" to take a new picture or tap the paper stack icon to access photos on your camera roll. Select the photo.
 - b. Tap "Edit" to add enhancements, effects, frames, stickers, and text. You can also crop your picture, fix red-eye, and draw on your photo. Swipe left and right to view all editing options. Tap "Done" when you have finished enhancing your photo.

Note: There are a limited number of free enhancements and stickers. More can be purchased within the app for nominal fees.

- c. Tap "More" to choose a background theme.
- 3. **Think about what you want to say or sing**. Think about and/or write down what you would like to say. Make a script or practice singing your *Shanah Tovah* message.
- 4. Record your Shanah Tovah message:
 - a. Tap the red microphone button to begin recording your message. Tap the screen again to stop recording. You can re-record your message before you send it as needed.
- 5. Share your Shanah Tovah with family and friends
 - a. Tap "Share."
 - b. Log in to your Fotobabble account if you are not already logged in.
 - c. Be sure to turn the Public setting to "Off."
 - d. Tap on "My Fotobabble" to change the caption/title of your message.
 - e. Tap "Email" to send your Shanah Tovah!
