Differentiation Options

Knowing that students learn in a variety of ways and modalities, the following options are provided to adjust the above lesson to meet the unique needs of your learners.

For learners who need more assistance

- Have students work in *hevruta* (partners) of your choosing. Be sure to vary the groups. Sometimes group children so that they are at the same level. Other times pair a stronger student with a student that needs more assistance.

For learners who need extension opportunities

- Provide any of these apps as an anchor activity. An anchor activity is available in the classroom as students finish other work. As students work with one or more of the apps, encourage them to begin to create their own *milon ivrit* (Hebrew dictionary). This can be done on paper or in an ebook creation app like Book Creator.
